(Jyotirling or Jyotirlingam is a shrine where the Lord is worshipped in the form of a Jyotirlingam or 'Lingam of Light'. There are 12 traditional Jyotirlinga shrines in India. It is believed that Shiva first manifested himself as a Jyotirlinga on the night of the Arudra festival, thus the special reverence for the Jyotirlinga. It is believed that a person can see these Lingas as columns of fire piercing through the earth after he reaches a higher level of spiritual attainment. The location of these Lingas of Light is given in another prayer called - Dwadasa Linga Sthavam.

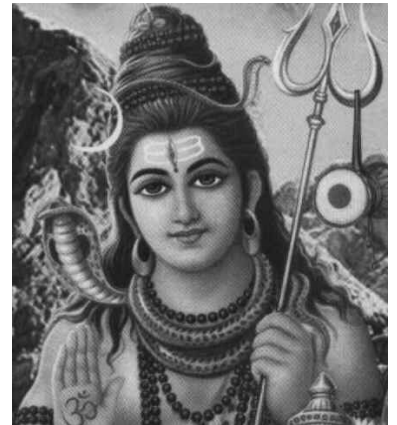
